NUMERACY NEWS

In numeracy we are looking at graphing, data and statistics. We have been acting as meterologists, collecting data on weather and in the next few weeks will be graphing this information using pictures and symbols.



To support the learning in the classroom, we encourage you to practice skip counting at home (or in the car) by 2's, 5's and 10's!

Literacy corner

Last Term we sent home the decoding strategies learnt in Prep and we have spent the first half of this term recapping these guys and what they do!

Last week we began introducing comprehension strategies as it is equally as important for students to understand what they read as it is to decode.

Our first furry friend is Questioning Owl! Questioning owl asks questions about the text before, during and after reading. Talk to your child about Questioning Owl and use this as a prompt when listening to them read.

Reminder that all nightly reading should be recorded in their diaries. You will also find in their diary their weekly spelling words.

STEM

We are extremely excited about our STEM unit this term, which is all about weather, seasons and clothing! Students will be designing clothing that is appropriate for our school and the weather conditions. We will be investigating materials and determining which will be most suitable for outside learning i.e. rain and cold temperatures. In order to test materials, we kindly ask for donations of scraps of different materials. For example:

• Plastic, wool, scrap fabric, buttons etc.

Any donations to our STEM program would be greatly appreciated and will add to the authenticity of our learning. Please bring any donations in a plastic bag. We thank you!



So far we have tested polar fleece and cotton to determine absorbency. In our triads, we have investigated these materials when dry and wet, describing them using adjectives and determining whether or not they are water proof.
