Numeracy-Term Three

- Measurement using informal and formal units.
- Length, capacity, mass

Literacy - Writing

- Children will work on procedural texts and attempt to write some using the correct format.
- Editing- Children will learn to edit their work, checking for meaning, punctuation and spelling.
- Children will use some 'WOW' words to make their writing more interesting.

Literacy- Reading

- Children will focus on the reading strategies we have covered.
- Expression and fluency will be a focus when reading aloud.
- We will investigate procedural texts and look at what they are used for.

SHOWCASE NERVES

It is completely normal for children to be nervous. We asked children to raise their hands if they were nervous about the Showcase and they almost all did. This happens every year and is a very normal part of the process. Our best advice is to tell the kids what the day will look like and then just don't over talk it. It is a fun day and by the time we actually do the performance the kids are usually desperate to get on with it. If your child is nervous it is essential you are ON TIME, kids become distressed when they arrive when something is already happening and they are unsure of what is going on. We promise we will look after them all and talk them through their nerves.

<u>SWIMMING</u>

The swimming program in Term 4 is a fabulous program, not only for the swimming component, but the bus travel and independent organization skills children learn whilst they are there. It is amazing how they manage when they need to. We are there to help them get changed and by day four they are usually competent to get most of it done themselves.
