FROM THE PRINCIPAL...

Thought for the week: The key to happiness is having dreams: the key to success is making them come true. - James Allen

Welcome back to Term 4. What a rollercoaster of a year we have had, but our resilience is getting us through. Our NAPLAN results have shown continued growth in our Year 3 and 5 students. There are still a few envelopes that will need to be collected from the front foyer.

I would also like to acknowledge our Tutor program from years 1-6, under the guidance of Kellie, Viv, Josie and Sarah. These staff have worked to develop a remote way for our students on this program to continue to show growth. A monumental effort.

Staff were re-energised and inspired by our Presenter (Emeritus Professor of Science, Mathematics and Technology Monash University) Peter Sullivan - Numeracy guru during our Curriculum Day yesterday. We are excited to commence implementation of many of his strategies and stories around the teaching of numeracy. The interaction of our staff was wonderful to observe and how staff were able to share with our Network.

On Monday 1st November we will be having a whole school planning day for teachers. This will involve employing Casual Relief Teachers for the day to take those who will be onsite, Authorised workers and Vulnerable children and Preps. The program will be altered to accommodate this planning. A reminder if you are intending to have an extended weekend please make sure you let us know. Before and After School will continue as normal.

Staff will commence preparing class groups for 2022 from this Monday and this involves looking at children's needs - both academically, behaviourally and socially. Our aim is to have balanced class groups in terms of academic ability, behaviour and social needs.

In the past teachers have asked the children to identify who they learn best with. This year we are incorporating a new system called Class Solver to assist in creating groups for classes next year. We are asking for parents to take the time, to have a considered discussion with their child, as to who they LEARN best with, not necessarily their best friends.

Each child should identify up to 5 children in their year level e.g. Year 4 in 2022. We hope with your assistance this will enable a consistent approach and reduce the anxiety for children and parents. After all the relevant data has been received, Class Solver will then ensure there is at least one child selected from their list.

FROM THE PRINCIPAL CONTINUED...

We are working towards a Step-Up morning for 2022 classes on Tuesday 11th of December, COVID-19 restrictions allowing. During this time children will meet with their new teacher and classmates. Teacher allocation will come home with your child's reports on this day.

I would like to extend an invitation to those parents who are not returning to The Patch in 2022, to write to me by Wednesday 6th November, so we are able to commence our grade allocations for 2022. If you have any pertinent information you wish to be considered in relation to this, please put it in writing and pass on to me by Wednesday November 6th.

The parent voluntary payments for 2022 will be placed on the website, along with the policy and processes for you to view after our School Council Meeting on Tuesday 27th October. We will send a hardcopy home at the beginning of the year but you are welcome to look and note what is required.

COVID-19 Vaccination Directions for All Education Workers

The Victorian Chief Health Officer has issued directions for required vaccinations for education workers. These directions are specific to education workers and supersede those for other authorised workers.

All staff who work in schools will be required to have a first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine by 18 October 2021 or be able to produce evidence of a vaccination booking within that week.

All staff are required to be fully vaccinated by 29 November 2021 unless a medical exception applies and will be required to show evidence of their vaccination status.

Getting vaccinated is the best way to protect yourself, your colleagues and students and the whole school community. Getting vaccinated will help slow the spread of COVID-19 and prevent future outbreaks in our schools.

The Department of Education and Training's website has frequently asked questions about the vaccine requirement.


