

This money will be used to purchase new construction equipment for our students, as well as contributing towards a purchase of a new MARIMBA for the music room!


As soon as they have been purchased, we will share some photos!! Thank you always for your continuing support!

SUSHI lunchorders are brought to us by a local family who own 2 local shops...The Blacksmith and SUSHI Express.


Please note your credit card lunch order payments will show on your statement as going out to The Blacksmith Belgrave.


